

## Zeppelin delivers Mobile Clinics to Papua New Guinea

Zeppelin has delivered two mobile clinics to the Goroka electorate in the Eastern Highlands province of Papua New Guinea. The clinics are realized in double-side expandable Zeppelin-Shelters and can either operate truck-mounted or on ground. They are equipped with a power generator and water tanks which makes them completely independent from any external source.

The first clinic combines a dental and an ophthalmology unit added by wall mounted working benches with integrates sinks and overhead cabinets. The second clinic serves as a general examination unit and for gynaecology treatment. The individual compartments are separated by curtains.

The clinics will mostly serve the rural population of the province. The country's medical infrastructure cannot cope with the topology which is dominated by forestry and jungle. As a consequence, off-road suitable mobile clinics which go out to the patients are the ideal solution for Papua New Guinea.
